• All entries will begin assembling on 103rd Ave, coming in on Highway 49 (Rolla Rd) at 8:00 a.m. with parade commencing at **10:00 a.m. sharp.**

• Judging of **pre-registered** entries and ribbon distribution will take place at 9:15 a.m. prior to the parade beginning. **If you are not in line at 9:00 am – you will not be judged**

• Entrants who have not registered with the Chamber of Commerce **will not** be judged!

• Entries must be able to keep up with the flow of the parade or they will be excused.

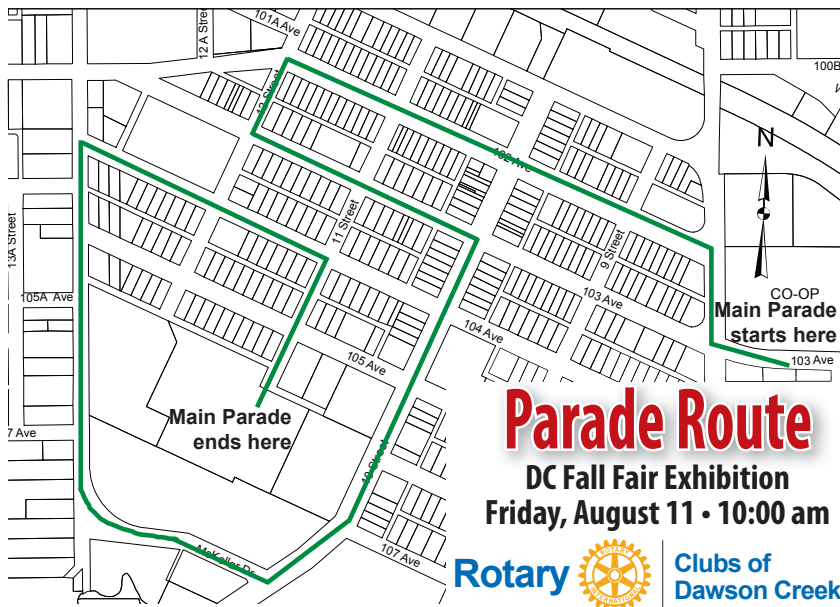
• Undecorated vehicles (except those in the Vintage Category) need not register.

• Entrants understand that photos will be taken of the parade and may be used in future publications and promotional materials.

• **NOTE:** Candy throwing is **NOT** permitted from floats for safety reasons, but can be handed out using walkers beside your float.

• Parade ends at The Kin and the Memorial Arena Parking Lot.

• We will need to know if you will have sound/music on the float.
